CONSENT JUDGMENT

THIS CAUSE, coming on to be heard before the undersigned Superior Court Judge Presiding, it having been stipulated by the parties and the Court finding as fact the following:

- 1. Plaintiff John H. Snowden, III, D/B/A/ The Independent, is a sole proprietorship doing business in Currituck County, North Carolina.
- 2. Defendant, Currituck County Board of Commissioners, is the governing body for Currituck County, North Carolina, a body corporate and politic existing pursuant to the laws of the State of North Carolina and consisting of the following named Defendants: Barry C. Nelms, Gene A. Gregory, Ernie Bowden, J. Owen Etheridge and Janet Taylor.
 - 3. On Monday, January 14, 2008, Defendants Barry C. Nelms,

- Gene A. Gregory and J. Owen Etheridge attended a tour of the Port of Virginia along with Currituck County Manger Daniel F. Scanlon, II, Currituck County Economic Development Director Peter Bishop, Currituck Planning Director Ben Woody, Currituck County Engineer Eric Weatherly, Currituck County Economic Development Board Member Kevin Burwell and county resident Bryan Bass.
- 4. Because a majority of the Defendant Currituck County Board of Commissioners attended the Port of Virginia tour such tour constituted an official meeting pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. §143-318.10(d) and pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. §143-318.12(b)(2) required public notice of the time and place of the tour 48 hours in advance of the tour.
- 5. The Defendant Currituck County Board of Commissioners did not give, or cause to be given, pubic notice of the time and place of the Port of Virginia tour as required by N.C. Gen. Stat. \$143-318.12(b)(2).
- 6. On February 28, 2007, Defendants Barry C. Nelms,
 Gene A. Gregory and J. Owen Etheridge attended a meeting with
 Currituck County's legislative delegation in Raleigh, North
 Carolina along with Currituck County Manger Daniel F. Scanlon, II
 and Currituck County Engineer Eric Weatherly.
- 7. Because a majority of the Defendant Currituck County Board of Commissioners attended the meeting with Currituck County's legislative delegation in Raleigh, North Carolina such meeting constituted an official meeting pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. §143-318.10(d) and pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. §143-318.12(b)(2) required public notice of the time and place of the meeting 48 hours in advance of the meeting.

8. The Defendant Currituck County Board of Commissioners did not give, or cause to be given, public notice of the time and place of the meeting with Currituck County's legislative delegation in Raleigh, North Carolina as required by N.C. Gen. Stat. §143-318.12(b)(2).

Based on the foregoing stipulated FINDINGS OF FACT, the Court CONCLUDES AS A MATTER OF LAW that the Defendant Currituck County Board of Commissioners did not comply with the provisions of N.C. Gen. Stat. §143-318.12(b)(2) when it failed to give public notice of the time and place of the tour to the Port of Virginia 48 hours in advance of the January 14, 2008 tour and by failing to give public notice of the time and place of the meeting in Raleigh, North Carolina with the Currituck County legislative delegation forty-eight hours in advance of the meeting.

NOW THEREFORE, it is ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:

- A. The Defendants shall hereafter comply with the official meeting notice requirements provided in N.C. Gen. Stat. §143-318.12.
- B. The Defendant Currituck County Board of Commissioners shall pay to the Plaintiff the filing fee for initiation of this action and attorney's fees incurred by Plaintiff as verified by receipts evidencing Plaintiff's payment of attorney's fees in this matter.
- C. Counsel for the Defendants represents by his signature below that he has been authorized by his respective clients to execute, and that his respective clients consent to entry of,

this Consent Judgment out of court and out of session. Plaintiff, appearing pro se, represents by his signature below that he consents to entry of this Consent Judgment out of court and out of session.

NOW COMES the Plaintiff, John H. Snowden, III D/B/A The Independent (the Plaintiff) and hereby alleges and sets forth his Complaint against Defendants, The Currituck County Board of Commissioners, and Daniel F. Scanlon, II in his capacity as Currituck County Manager (collectively "Defendants").

- 1. This is a declaratory judgment action filed pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 143-318.16A and an action for an injunction prohibiting the Defendants from meeting without properly advertising any such meetings pursuant to NCGS 143-318.12(b)(2).
- 2. Plaintiff John H. Snowden, III D/B/A The Independent, is a sole proprietorship doing business in Currituck County. He publishes a weekly newspaper of general circulation in Currituck County.
- 3. Defendant, The Currituck County Board of Commissioners is a body politic, representing Currituck County, a political subdivision of the State of North Carolina.
 - 4. Defendant, Nelms is chairman of the Currituck County Board of Commissioners
 - 5. Defendant, Gregory is vice chairman of the Currituck County Board of Commissioners.
 - 6. Defendant, Bowden is a member of the Currituck County Board of Commissioners
 - 7. Defendant, Etheridge is a member of the Currituck County Board of Commissioners

- 8. Defendant, Taylor is a member of the Currituck County Board of Commissioners
- 9. Defendant, Scanlon is the County Manager of Currituck County
- 10. Venue of this action is proper in Currituck County.
- 11. Defendants may be sued and held liable in a civil action.
- 12. On Monday, January 14, 2008, three members of the Currituck County Board of Commissioners (Nelms, Gregory, & Etheridge), the Currituck County Manager (Daniel F. Scanlon, II), the Currituck County Economic Development Director Peter Bishop), the Currituck County Planning Director Ben Woody, the Currituck County Engineer Eric Weatherly, Currituck County Economic Development Board Member Kevin Burwell, and Moyock Resident Bryan Bass attended a tour of the Port of Virginia, Norfolk Terminal (hereinafter referred to as "THE TOUR".
 - 13. The Currituck County Board of Commissioners consists of five board members.
- 14. THE TOUR constituted an official meeting, hereinafter referred to as THE MEETING, of the Defendant, as a quorom (3 of 5) of the Board members were present.
- 15. The Defendants had a reasonable understanding that such a meeting of the Board of Commissioners, in their official capacity, must be adequately advertised to the public.
- 16. The Defendants failed to advertise this official meeting as required pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 143-318.12(b)(2).
- 17. The Defendants knew of the meeting as early as the evening of Monday, January 7, 2008, and had sufficient time to provide adequate advance notice for the meeting to be advertised as required by N.C.G.S. § 143-318.12(b)(2).
- 18. On February 28, 2007, Currituck Board of Commissioners Chairman Barry Nelms, Vice Chair Gene Gregory, Commissioner Owen Etheridge, County Manager Dan Scanlon and County Engineer Eric Weatherly took a trip, similar to THE TOUR, to Raleigh to meet with Representative W.C. "Bill" Owens, and Senator Marc Basnight to discuss legislative goals for the county.
- 19. That the February 28, 2007 meeting, like the recent one to THE TOUR was not advertised to the public or media.
- That Daniel F. Scanlon, II, Currituck County Manager, acknowledged in an email dated March 16, 2007 (See Exhibit A attached hereto) "yes. we should have advertised this meeting." with regards to the February 28, 2007 meeting.
 - 21. That Scanlon also stated that the Defendants would "from this point forward properly advertise

our trips pursuant to the requirements of the Open Meetings Law."

22. In light of the failure to properly advertise the February 28, 2007 meeting, and the most recent failure to properly advertise the January 14, 2008 meeting, the Defendants exhibit a recurring pattern of violation of the requirements to adequately advertise public meetings pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 143-318.12(b)(2).

REQUEST FOR DECLARATORY JUDGMENT

- 23. The allegations of the previous paragraphs are hereby reasserted and incorporated by reference.
- 24. Plaintiff has a direct and substantial interest in having a judicial determination that the Monday, January 14, 2008 meeting (THE TOUR) held at the Port of Virginia, Norfolk Terminal was an offical meeting of the Defendant, which was not advertised to the public.
 - 25. Plaintiff may seek judicial remedy pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 143-318.16A(a).
 - 26. Plaintiff meets burden of N.C.G.S. § 143-318.16A(b).
- 27. Plaintiff seeks a judgment declaring that the January 14, 2008 meetings of the Currituck County Board of Commissioners were not properly advertised pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 143-318.12(b)(2).
- 28. As a result of the foregoing, the parties have an ongoing and actual controversy between the parties related to their rights and obligations regarding the matters set forth in this complaint.

REQUEST FOR INJUNCTION

- 29. The allegations of the previous paragraphs are hereby reasserted and incorporated by reference.
- 30. Plaintiff seeks and is entitled to an injunction prohibiting the Defendants from conducting any official meetings without properly advertising said meetings pursuant to NCGS 143-318.12(b)(2).

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff request as follows:

- 1. That the court enter a judgment declaring the Monday, January 14, 2008 meeting held by the Defendant at the Port of Virginia, Norfolk Terminal in violation of N.C.G.S. § 143-318.12(b)(2).
- 2. That the court pursuant to N.C.G.S 143-318.16C set this action for immediate hearing, with subsequent proceedings in such actions accorded priority.
- 3. That the court enter preliminary and permanent injunctions prohibiting the Defendant from further violation of N.C.G.S. § 143-318.12(b)(2)

- 4. That Plaintiff recover cost of this action , pursuant to N.C.G.S.§ 143-318.16B, including attorney's fees as permitted by law; and
 - 5. For such other further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.
